Aruba Central switch deployment with Aruba Installer

iOS and Android

PURPOSE

The new Aruba Installer app for iOS and Android speeds the process of deploying equipment to an Aruba Central-managed site by allowing installers to quickly scan device information using a smartphone camera, reducing manual entry workloads and making the deployment process more efficient.

PREREQUISITES

Site definition in Aruba Central

The first step is to create sites in Central to which devices are to be deployed. Navigate to **Global Settings** -> **Labels and Sites**, and toggle the switch in the top-right corner so that **Sites** is highlighted.

LABELS AND SITES

Labels are logical sets of devices which can be used for a variety of monitoring and reporting purposes. Each device can be associated with up to five labels, and a label can apply to as many devices as you want.

Sites allow you to group devices based on the location context.





To create a new site, use the **New Site** link in the bottom left corner. This will display the **Create New Site** popup; populate all fields, and click or tap **Add** to finish creating the site. Repeat the process until all sites to be deployed have been created.

Assign authorized installers


The second step defines users who will be authorized to use the Aruba Installer app to deploy equipment to specific sites. Navigate to **Install Manager -> INSTALLERS**.

Use the **ADD INSTALLER** link in the bottom left corner to create a new authorized installer account.

Each installer can be authorized to deploy and manage equipment at one or multiple sites; to add additional sites, simply type additional site names after each site has been added to the list. Once all authorized sites have been added, click or tap **SAVE** in the bottom left corner. Repeat the process until all authorized installer accounts have been created.

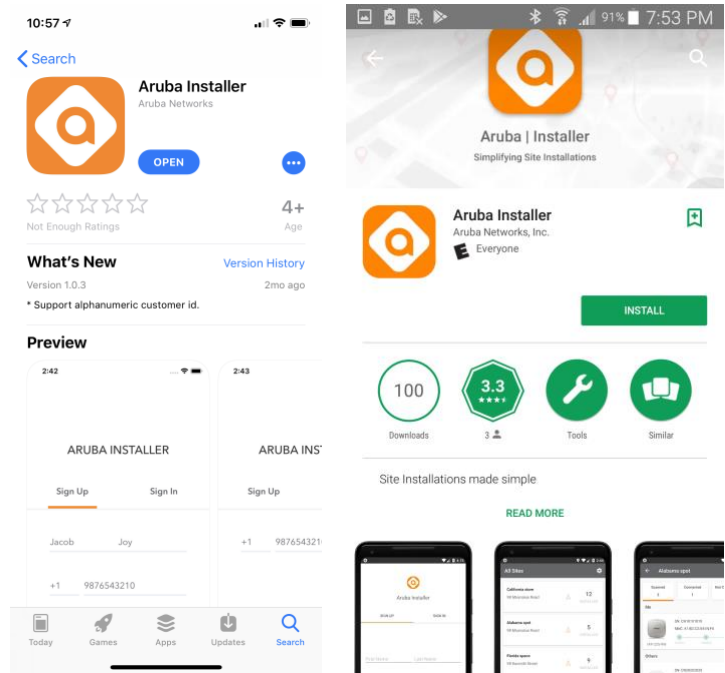

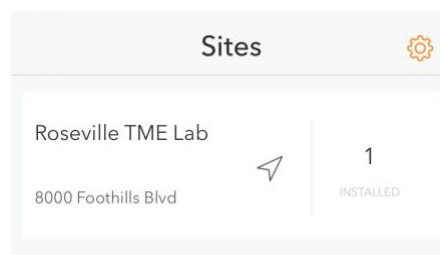

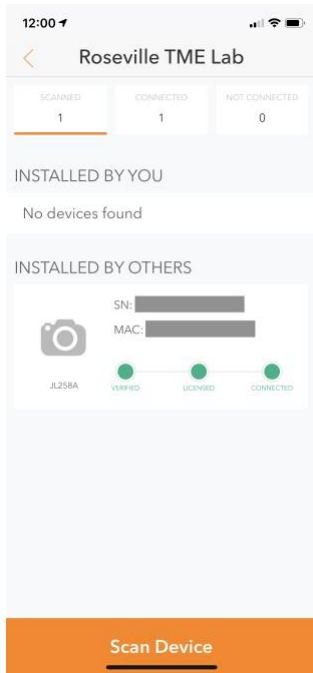

Once installed and launched, an authorized installer may complete the registration process by entering their name and phone number, then a one-time password (OTP) sent via text message that is used to verify the number and login for the first time.

After logging in, the installer will see a list of the sites for which they have been authorized, with address and the number of devices that have been deployed to that site.

Tapping the location icon allows the installer to open the site address in a mapping application. Tapping anywhere else in the site listing opens the site detail view, listing devices that have already been installed by the current account and by other accounts.





To install a device and assign it to the current site, tap the **Scan Device** button to the bottom of the view. If prompted, grant the app access to the camera. When the live camera view is displayed, focus the devices' serial number and MAC address barcodes within the displayed rectangle; when a barcode is successfully scanned, a popup will appear in the bottom of the view containing the scanned information.

Once the device has been identified and licensing has been verified in Central, the device will be added to the site, and can then be powered on and connected to the network in order to be managed (or monitored) by Central.
